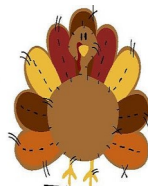

Did you know Mountain View is a PBIS School? So, what does PBIS stand for? It's Positive Behavior Intervention and Support. For the past 2 years, the MV staff has been working hard to implement this researched based behavior model to teach and implement school wide expectations and good behavior around the MV campus. If you haven't noticed, we have signage throughout our campus detailing expectations about behavior in the cafeteria, restroom, classroom, playground, etc. Our school

wide behaviors are called GRRS, which mean be Golden, be Responsible, be Respectful and be Safe. Every morning on announcements, we remind our student to follow the GRRS in all areas of our school. For students who demonstrate their GRRS, they receive blue tickets to be redeemed every Wednesday at our Bear Cave, a student incentive store. Students also earn gold tickets for our quarterly drawing of gift cards. In addition, they earn points in the cafeteria for good behavior (which earns them an extended 10 minute at lunch recess on Fridays). They also earn classroom points for daily attendance, being on time, and turning in their homework. Please ask your students about the GRRS. They should be able to tell you all about them. We appreciate your support in encouraging your students to practice their GRRS in all areas of their life, not just on the MV campus.
