Progress Reports

All students in Grades 2-6 should be coming home on 9/30 with their academic progress report. This is a reflection of the work done to this point in the year and should be viewed not as a messenger of doom or a badge of guaranteed success, but as an opportunity to talk with your student about their areas of need, develop some strategies for success, and make plans for continued growth.

Recommendations moving forward:

- Communicate with your child's teacher if you see areas of great deficit or are surprised by missing/incomplete work. Please reach out to your teacher - they are the greatest resource on our campus!
- Set realistic goals and make a concrete plan with your child to celebrate when they attain those goals. It doesn't have to be a trip to Disneyland for straight A's - kids enjoy earning dinner at their favorite restaurant or a new game for their X-Box. Also, moving a grade up from a D to a C is sometimes harder than moving from a B to an A - those improvements should be appreciated and celebrated in your home right along with the higher marks.
- The end of the 1st Quarter is October 21. Students have three solid weeks to make gains on their grades - be diligent in checking planners, reviewing Parent Connect, and looking over homework each night
