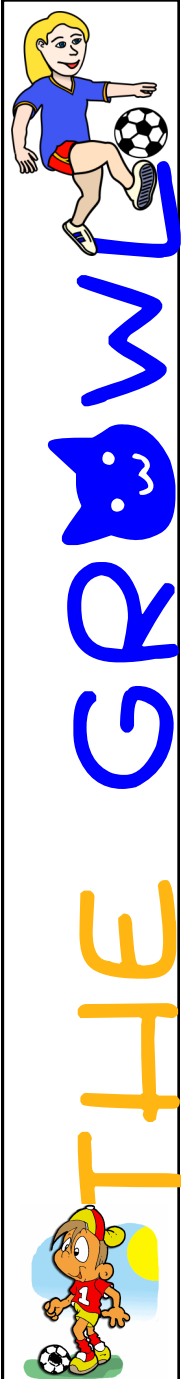

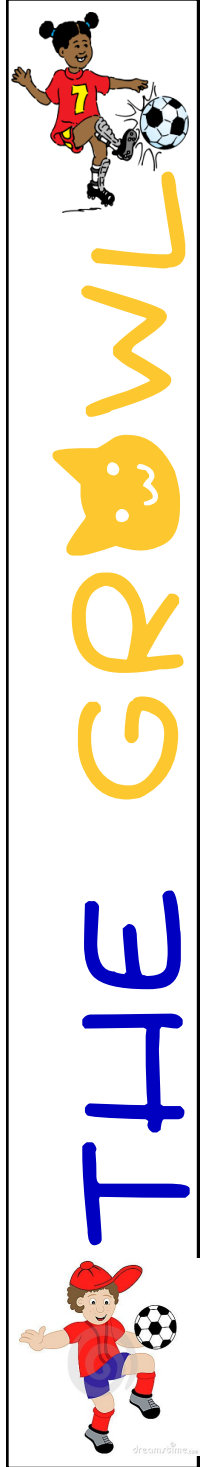

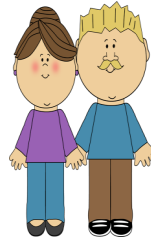

Mawlid an-Nabi is a day that celebrates the birth of the prophet Muhammad, the founder of Islam. Muslims all over the world celebrate Mawlid an-Nabi. The Sunni Muslims celebrate on the 12th day of the Islamic month of Rabi' al-Awwal, while the Shia Muslims celebrate on the 17th day. Mosques and homes are cleaned and decorated for the special occasion. Parades are held with people carrying green banners. Men wear green clothing; girls usually wear pink and white. Special foods are prepared and handed out. Believers sing songs and chant special prayers.
