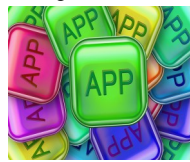

How to Apply for No-Cost Meal Benefits

To apply for no-cost breakfast and lunch benefits, **households must complete a new application each school year.** 2018/2019 No-Cost Meal Application processing will commence at the beginning of August, 2018. If your student received no-cost meals at a CUSD school during the 2017-2018 school year, his/her benefits status will remain the same for the first 30 operating days of the school year or until a 2018-2019 application has been processed.

Apply online: visit Parent Connection or <https://qweb.clovisusd.k12.ca.us/FSONline/Main/Login> to apply for no cost meal benefits online.

Complete and submit paper application: 2018-2019 applications are available in the Mountain View office, in the campus catering office, and are distributed to all households at the beginning of each new school year, with a letter informing them of the availability of no-cost and reduced-price breakfast and lunch for children enrolled in CUSD schools. Applications may be submitted any time during the school year.
